Needle Felting Kit – Sheep \$29.00 (Must order by July 16 to receive kit by class date) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Instructor recommendation: https://www.etsy.com/listing/754454088/loon-needle-felting-kit-diy• If you choose to supply your own materials and don't want to purchase the kit, please source these items: Pipe cleaner preferably black (one per loon), foam or brush work pad (an old pillow can work too), 38 gauge 3-sided felting needles, 1 oz black wool roving, small amounts white wool roving, 2 red glass beads for eyes, and needle and black sewing thread.
