Building an Embroidery Sketchbook: Foundational Stitches

Please bring with you to class:

Materials fee \$25, payable to the instructor (includes 3 embroidery samplers, designed by the instructor and printed on fabric to use in class for students to keep, muslin cloth to use as backing material, and free use of instructor's additional threads for experimentation)

6" embroidery hoop

Embroidery needles (size 7 or an assorted size package; pick up the TULIP thin selection in our shop: <https://textilecentermn.org/product/textile-tools/>

Minimum of 6 cotton embroidery thread skeins of different colors

Scissors (optional)

Thimble (optional)

Additional lighting (optional)

Beeswax or other thread conditioner (optional)
